

Spatial Viewer Quick Reference Guide

1 Locate and open the Spatial Viewer

To open the Spatial Viewer click "Find a Property" link from the Planning Portal, this will open the Spatial Viewer as a separate site.

Alternatively, you can enter the web address
<https://www.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/spatialviewer/>

You'll be asked to accept the terms and conditions.

2 Search

Address: click the address icon and enter the address into the search bar

Lot: click on the lot icon and enter the lot/section/DP in the search bar.

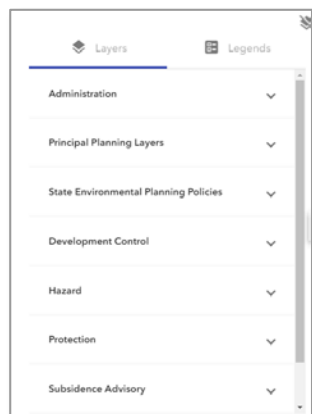
LGA: click on the LGA icon and enter the NSW region you would like to search in the search bar.

POI: click on the POI icon and enter the point of interest.

Note: To begin a new search click "search for a property/ Lot " icon.

3 Layers and Legends

1. Select the layers tab and select the layers required

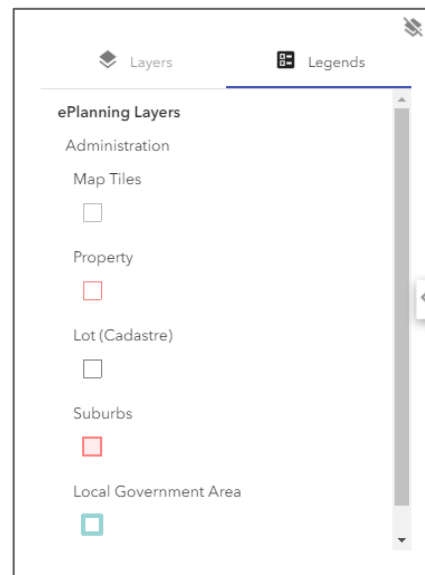


Note: Click on the headings & open the options

1. Click to open a separate site where you can download spatial data sets.
2. Click to adjust the opacity.

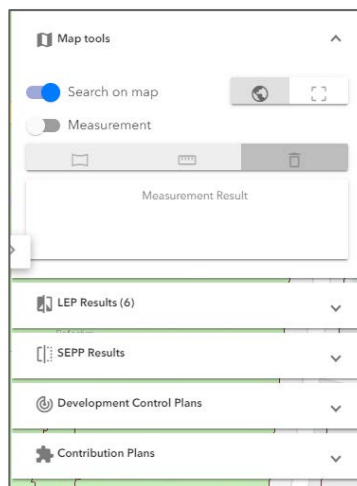
Note: You can open and minimise the layer section by clicking on these icons.

4. The Legend shows how layers will appear on the map.



4 Map tools

1. On the top right hand side of the map, tabs with drop down boxes will appear relating to the search criteria you have entered.
2. Click on the arrow on the tab to drop down the options to find more information about the area you have selected.



Note: Clicking on some functions may take you to an external link.

5 Property report

1. To generate a property report click the icon in the top left corner next to the search bar.

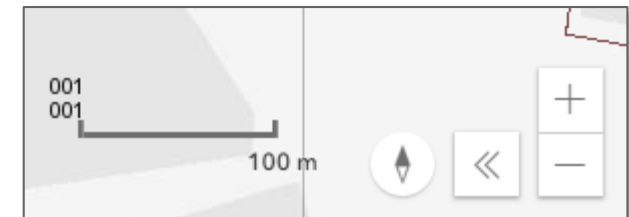


Note: When generating a report allow pop ups to be accepted.

2. The property report will be downloaded as a PDF file to your computer.

6 Adjusting and reading the map

1. In the bottom right corner you will find controls to help use the map. This includes a compass, zoom in and out, scale and an arrow opening different ways to view the background/base map.



Note: Click the compass to re-orientate the map to North.

Note: Zooming will change the scale of the map.

2. Select the arrow at the bottom right corner to apply the five available options when viewing the map.
