SCHEDULE 2

1. Delete condition 27B of Schedule A, and replace with

<u>Erosion and Sediment Control – Wildlife Lake Weir and Flood Outlet & Water Discharge Locations</u> 14-16

The applicant shall implement the Erosion and Sediment Control Plans (ESCPs) for the Wildlife Lake Weir, Wildlife Lake Flood Outlet Pipe, and Water Discharge Locations 14-16 included in DA4 MOD 6.

The Applicant is permitted to use the existing water body, "Lewis Lagoon", to regulate water quality control as part of the Penrith Lakes Scheme to treat runoff water before entering the Wildlife Lake. The Applicant is to maintain the existing hydraulic behaviour of the Lagoon and monitor and maintain Lewis Lagoon in accordance with the Water Quality Strategy, Interim Lakes Operating Plan for Penrith Lakes Scheme and the Water Management Plan.
