





## Declare As-Builts (Final Set)

As part of the Design and Building Practitioners Act 2020, Building Practitioners (BP) are required to declare the As-Builts (final set) Construction Issued Regulated Design (CIRD) documents.

This guide will demonstrate how the BP can declare the As-Builts on the NSW Planning Portal.

**Note:** The Declaration of As-Builts (final set) documents can only be performed by the Building Practitioner.

1. From the dashboard, <b>click</b> on the Remediation Works case that requires the As-Built (final set) declaration.	
2. <b>Click</b> Actions, then <b>click</b> Declare As-Builts (Final set) from the options.	
3. <b>Indicate</b> if you are ready to confirm your As-Built (Final set) documents.	
<b>Note:</b> If you select No above, the system will allow you the opportunity to upload and lodge further design variation documents. Please follow the steps to uploading design variation documents, keeping in mind that the submission from this screen will upload and lodge the documents as declared designs.	
4. Indicate if the building work complied with the Building Code of Australia.	
<b>Note:</b> You will be required to enter steps taken to ensure compliance.
