School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW), as part of Department of Education (the Department), welcomes the Department of Planning and Environment's (DPE) invitation to provide comments on the Explanation of Intended Effect for the Interim Metro Review of the draft Sydney Olympic Park (SOP) Master Plan 2030 (the draft Plan).

SINSW understands that an amendment is required to the *State Environmental Planning Policy (State Significant Precincts) 2005* (SSP SEPP) to update the current draft Plan to facilitate the delivery of Sydney Metro West within the SOP town centre.

SINSW notes that the entirety of the proposed amendments are to the Central Precinct which is sufficiently distanced from the closest educational establishment. As a result, SINSW is generally supportive of the proposal and acknowledge that at completion, the Metro will likely provide a range of on-going positive outcomes for schools and communities in proximity to the proposed alignment, including reducing localised traffic, improved access, and the promotion of sustainable travel.
