**Draft GPEC Strategic Framework:**

- Figure 10 and Figure 13 show only avoided land layer while it is recommended to show other CPCP layers such as certified urban capable land.
- Figure 14 does not show CPCP layers. It is required to show CPCP avoided land and include a clarification that the Potential Future Employment Areas is partially avoided land and future development would only be happening on the certified land.
- Utilities and Services map (page 68) and Transport map (page 72) do not show the CPCP layers where some of the proposed pipelines and linear infrastructure does cross avoided land and therefore the proposed infrastructure may need to address the CPCP Infrastructure Guidelines..
- Part 6 - implementation of the strategic framework is recommended to include the CPCP planning controls (Biodiversity and Conservation SEPP 2021 and section 9.1 Ministerial Direction).
